They have ACCESS TO MEDIA

they heard

ASK about what is being said

VALIDATE their feelings

LISTEN/HEAR them!



Follow a Process to Move Them Into Action

HELP THEM SEE THINGS

- Avoid being analytic/critical
- Help them be aware of the impact

CREATE NO JUDGEMENT ZONE

- Explore issues/feelings
- Not being judgmental

BE ATTENTIVE

- Don't move trough impact, help then understand

- Demonstrate Solidarity

VIGIL PRAYERS

- Pray for victims of crisis, refugees and all displaced people. Help Youth create the prayers.
