6pm Mass, 7:15pm Presentation (or immediately following Mass)

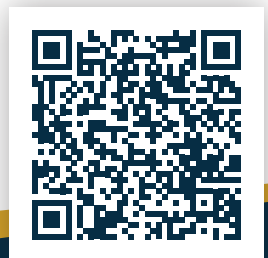
